Introduction:

While distance education has been promoted for years, it has not been the main model of education. In 2020, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, approximately 90 percent of schools around the world have temporarily closed and initiated remote teaching programs. Distance education is expected to become one of the dominant learning approaches in the post-pandemic era. This workshop will share Taiwan's implementation methods and experience for distance learning to support partner countries in developing resilient education systems.

Objectives:

- Taiwan's online course degree certification and evaluation mechanism.
- Learner-centered curriculum design combining ICT support and innovative digital teaching means.
- Training of educators on digital teaching ability.

The issues this webinar will address:

- How to resolve the distance education gap caused by the inequality of ICT resources and insufficient teaching capacity.
- Opportunities of cross-domain cooperation for innovation education.

Contents:

- Sharing the development of Taiwan's online courses, and resource allocation in education.
- Strengthening digital teaching human resources through sharing remote-teaching experiences and training seed teachers.
- Developing distance learning designs suitable for different circumstances through the integration of multiple online education platforms and social media.
